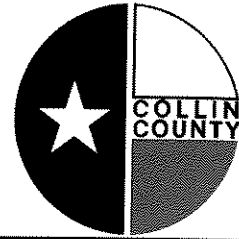

 the 121 into meeting.

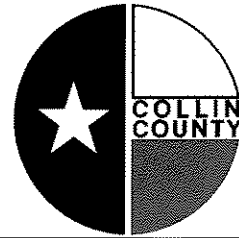
CR 424 ~~does~~ not to be a 4 lane divided

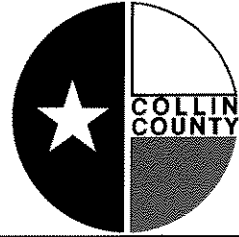

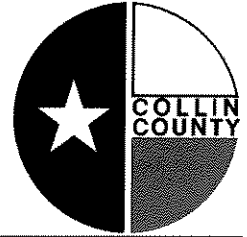

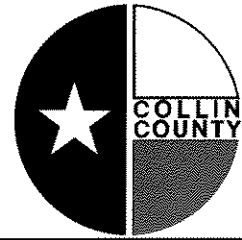
